Why Report an ADR?

Reporting ADRs helps to:

- Enhance patient safety and well-being.
- Support continuous monitoring of medicine safety.
- Identify and evaluate potential risks associated with medicines.
- Improve the safe and effective use of pharmaceutical products.
- Strengthen pharmacovigilance and regulatory compliance.

Who Can Report?

Suspected ADRs can be reported by:

- Doctors
- Pharmacists
- Nurses
- Other Healthcare Professionals
- Patients and Caregivers

How to Report

If you suspect an Adverse Drug Reaction:

1. Consult your treating healthcare professional immediately.
2. Note important information such as the medicine name, dosage, date of use, and symptoms experienced.
